

A poor-house building near Bath, N. Y. was fired by an insane pauper, on Saturday night, and burned down. Fifteen of the inmates perished.

Thirty frame houses in the lower section of Harrisburg, owned by the Lehigh Valley Company, were burned on Saturday evening. About half of them were unoccupied, and the loss is not heavy. The origin of the fire is unknown.

Three arrived at New York during March 4888 immigrants, of whom 1582 were females. The total immigration to New York during the quarter ending March 31st, was 8786, against 7250 during the corresponding period of last year.

For the three-quarters of the current fiscal year ending March 31st the receipts of the Government have been \$194,556,490, and the expenditures, exclusive of debt interest, \$99,810,526, a decrease, compared with the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year, of \$7,516,289 in receipts and \$12,830, 216 in expenditures.

O. F. Kallard, the fugitive ex-Representative of Chester county, this State, has been caught. The district attorney at Chester received a telegraphic dispatch Monday from C. M. Kishbaugh, of Wyalusing, Bedford co., stating that he "held Kallard, subject to others." When arrested he is said to have been dressed as a drover or farmer in a rough suit of grey broad, and that he had shaved off his heavy beard.

The Post-office Appropriation bill, as agreed upon by the House Committee, appropriates \$23,199,473, which is \$2,257,398 below the estimate of the Post-office Department, and \$862,900 less than the appropriation for the current year. The bill reduces the compensation of the railroads five per cent., and provides that Postmasters of the fourth class shall be paid a commission on the stamps they cancel, instead of on those they sell.

Says the N. Y. Sun: A plan for amending the provisions of the Constitution for electing a President of the United States has been agreed upon by a committee of the House of Representatives. The scheme, so far as we can judge, is intricate and complicated; at all events, the telegraph operator who gives an account of it does not appear to understand it. But this makes little difference. Whether it is intelligible or not we do not want any amendment of the Constitution in this respect. We have more Constitution now than anybody pays any regard to. First, let us learn to observe and obey what we have; and then it will be time enough to talk about amendments. The Constitution as it is, worked well enough as long as it was carried into effect. It would have worked well the last time, if it had been obeyed. It is all a shallow pretence that we need any change in the Constitution.
