An Episcopalian school in which girls are trained for servants has been established in New York.

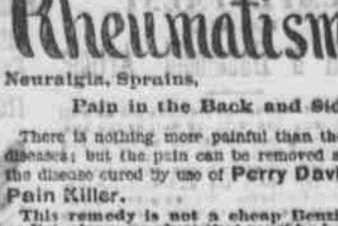
