An Important Bill.

AN ACT supplementary to an Act to consolidate, revise and amend the penal laws of this Commonwealth...

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania...

Sec. 2. That if any person or persons within this Commonwealth shall build, construct, alter or fit out...

Sec. 3. That if any person or persons within this Commonwealth shall build, construct, alter or fit out...

An Act for the Better Organization of the Militia of the Commonwealth.

The following is the law adopted last week at Harrisburg...

Sec. 1. Be it enacted, etc., That the grand staff of the militia of this Commonwealth shall, in addition to the commander in chief...

Sec. 2. That the adjutant general shall receive a salary of five hundred dollars per annum...

Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the officers before named to proceed at once to a thorough organization of the militia...

Sec. 4. That for the purpose of organizing, equipping, and arming the militia of this State, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars...

Sec. 5. That should the ordinary revenues of the State not be realized in time to meet the expenditures...

Sec. 6. That the adjutant general, quartermaster general, and commissary general shall expend such amounts of the money appropriated...

Sec. 7. That so much of any laws as may be supplied by or conflict with the provisions of this act be, and the same are hereby, repealed.

Sec. 8. That the following is a list of the township officers elected at the recent election:
