

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Filler-column of the Senate and House of Representatives. Having been expressed on an extraordinary occasion, as authorized by the Constitution, your attention is not called to any ordinary subject of legislation.

At the beginning of the present presidential term, four months ago, the functions of the Executive Department were generally suspended within the several States of South Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana and Florida, excepting only those of the Executive Department.
