four before we get if from the nursery, seldom less than five years more before it begins to bear, and some five years have to be added before we can get anything like a full crop. If we had but about fifteen more it would hardly be worth the while to grow fruit trees. Thirty years of such husbandry would require that we calculated about three years to a full crop from the ground, which would be worse than giving a whole year to nothing, as was once the rule in summer-fallowing. We rather suspect that where trees cease to be profitable after thirty years of age, it is from some neglect which has affected the constitution of the tree, It may be that borers have been allowed to board and lodge in the trunk free of charge for the accomodation ; or the soil has been allowed to become too poor; or they have been allowed to bear all they were disposed to do without thinning or assistance of any kind ; in any of which cases thirty years would undoubtledly do for them.

If all these things are properly seen to, and all the other little matters attended to that those who cultivate fruit for profit ought to know about, there is no reason why an apple tree may not be profitable for fifty years, either in the West or anywhere.


