Winter Arrangements.

Germtown Telegraph. As we now enter upon a four months of winter weather, in which we shall have more or less freezing and thawing, raining and snowing, and at times we may say half the time—the ground saturated with water, and the walking outside of the buildings obstructed with mud and slush, it becomes every head of a family to make such arrangements about his premises as shall in a great measure obviate this very serious inconvenience and promoter of sickness, often requiring heavy doctor's bills, to say nothing of loss of time etc. Anyone can very soon estimate the cost of the necessary walks and roads about the premises and set it against the risk and inconvenience we have named. There are nearly always boards, stones and bricks about a place; but when otherwise they should be purchased and hauled at odd times when the team is unemployed, and then before bad weather sets in—say not later than the first of December—grade the earth a little and lay them firmly down. Thus, make a dry, hard road to the cattle stalls, to the pig-pens, to the horse stables, to the pump, the wood-house to the spring-house; and then, when the clothes are dried out of doors, as is generally the case in the country, spread along the lines—which lines should be of galvanized wire—a thick layer of coal-ashes and roll it. This should be renewed about once in the winter, so that the moisture shall not penetrate through it to the shoes. The comfort of such an arrangement cannot be anticipated. Going out, and attending to matters and things about the premises, and returning with dry, clean shoes, is an enjoyment that must be realized to appreciate it. In addition to these, there are many other little matters that should be provided for before winter sets in. Boxes and barrels should be set near the house, under a shed, and out of view, for collecting refuse trash of every kind; but these should never be put in boxes or barrels or any wooden vessels or thing, owing to danger from fire. Hundreds of dwellings have been destroyed from this cause. For ashes it is recommended that a hole, say two or three feet deep, should be dug in the ground and lined up with brick and stone and left open at one side for the removal of the ashes when necessary. This once made will last for a generation, and will prove a sure protection against any danger from this cause. Of course there should be a shelter for coal, and kindling wood should always be prepared for making fires. Piles of anything movable that the wind may disturb should never be made about the house. The opening and keeping open of gutters should always be attended to, and ice walks and places should be sprinkled with ashes whenever needed and without delay. Boys, when they get old enough, should be taught to take them to make them assist in the work.
