Hillsgley's Bill.

Democratic Senatorial Districts Wiped Out. Pittsburgh Post Harrisburg Correspondence.

But let us look a little into the details of this infamous assault upon the rights of representation of the people of the Democratic counties in senatorial districts and carving Republican districts out of Democratic counties, shows the master hand of an artist and displays the ready invention—the abundant resources and unparalleled audacity of the Cameron coteries.

By the appointment of 1870 Lehigh and Northampton each compose a district, while Monroe, Pike and Carbon constituted a third, all strongly Democratic and represented in the present senate by Holben, Blanton and Craig, respectively. Lehigh has a population according to the census of 1880, of 65,906, Northampton of 70,816 and Monroe, Carbon and Pike, of 61,758 in the aggregate, and yet in defiance of all decency, this committee has "singed" Craig's district into the Cameron "man's," attaching Carbon to Lehigh, Lehigh and Pike to Northampton, and Monroe to the district of Cooper, who is a chief of the Cameron ring. It will be seen that the Democratic "man" have composed of Lehigh and Carbon, a population of 97,891, and the Democratic district made up of Northumberland, Monroe and Pike will have a population of 100,152 against the 56,102 of the Radical district of Delaware county. The district composed of the counties of Lycoming, Montour and Columbia, represented by McHenry, Democrat, was cut out, Sullivan being joined to Bradford and Wyoming, which will continue to send the Radical, Davies; Lycoming to Tioga, which will make a new Republican district, and Montour and Columbia to Northumberland which will make a district overwhelmingly Democratic, while Union and Snyder are taken from Northumberland and joined to Juniata to make a Republican district. The Democratic district composed of the counties of Juniata, Perry and Mifflin is also wiped out, Perry being joined to Franklin and Mifflin to a district made up of Huntingdon, Mifflin and Fulton counties, the latter districts being Republican. The county of Lackawanna is made into a separate district, which will be Republican, Luzerne into two, one being Republican. The Third district, Philadelphia, is strengthened for the Republicans to prevent it from being captured by a Democrat, as was done by Gordon at the last election, and Philadelphia will have hereafter but one Democratic senator out of the eight.
