Tobacco.

Leaf Seed and Havana. U. S. Tobacco Journal.

The closing remarks in our last week's report were: "Judging from the 'investment' spirit with which jobbers, as well as manufacturers, are imbued, further large sales of '80 tobacco will take place here by..."

A few hundred cases of '90 Housatonic were sold to a jobbing firm. In old tobacco good activity prevailed, with prices firm.

The prices for the '90 Pennsylvania sold are given at 18 to 20 cents. Havana—Market quiet. Very few sales of any magnitude were reported.

Trade Notes. The Leaf reports the Philadelphia market as follows: "Owing to the absence of desirable stock sales for the past week have been light, but the fortunate dealer who has the needed raw material is happy, as the profit is handsome."

The New York market is briefly reported thus by Fisher & Bro: There has been a brisk demand for seed leaf, especially for Pennsylvania. The market may be regarded as an active one, buying being liberal and the feeling of the trade buoyant to an unusual degree.
