U. S. Tobacco Journal. The closing remarks in our last week's report were: "Judging from the 'invest-ment' spirit with which jobbers, as well as manufacturers, are imbued, further large sales of '80 tobacco will take place shortly ;" and further large sales have taken place. No less than 3,000 cases of '80 Pennsylvania changed hands this week, the bulk of it being taken by manufac turers. A sale of 1,400 cases created quite a surprise. It was to a manufacturing firm which heretofore was estimated as but a medium-sized one, possessing neither much capital nor extensive manufacturing facilities. A sale of 1,400 cases, therefore, to such a concern was a novelty. Those familiar with the conditions of the sale say that the tobacco was sold subject to an agreement that 100 cases be delivered each month. This way of doing business is calculated to instigate other mediumsized manufacturers to follow suit, and we should not be surprised to see them come forward and secure sufficient of one kind of tobacco to last them a year or longer in this way. The large packer will no doubt prefer it. The jobber, who might pay sooner than the sort of manufacturers referred to, is not, however, quite so willing to pay the profit de-

A few hundred cases of '80 Housatonic were sold to a jobbing firm. In old tobaccos good activity prevailed, with prices firm. The total sales amounted to about 1,100 cases, mostly '79 Pennsylvania.

The market may be regarded as an active one, buying being liberal and the feeling of the trade buoyant to an unusual degree. All the indications point toward a lively trade in this

Charles Spitzner & Son 696 cases Pennsylvania to Messrs. Brown & Earle; Spear & Held sold 100 cases '79 Pa. to Rokohl & Rankin; a packing of 300 cases of '80 Pa. was sold by G. Fatk & Bro. to E. Bach & Son.
