Country Gentleman. When a farmer plants a large field of potatoes his neighbors are apt to rally him on his care in "providing for the bugs." But in some cases this should be profusely done. In every field of early planted potatoes a few rows of some late growing variety should be planted on which the bugs can concentrate after the early vines have died. It does not need many. These late hills should be visited twice a day at least for a week or more. In this way a friend of mine last year destroyed literally millions of the bugs from his own and neighbor's fields. Panning these late hills is preferable to using Paris green, as many of the old beetles would not eat, and would thus escape. A few hills of Peerless planted as late as July 1 would be green until killed by frost, might ripen some potatoes. Nero wished that all Rome had only one neck that he might more easily destroy it. So far as possible the potato bug should be full information.

That the old beetles will fly is unquestionable, but they rarely or never fly far at a time, and if the farmer destroys the bugs on his own land he need borrow no trouble about visits from those of his neighbors.

Fertilizers in Pennsylvania.

The chemist of the state board of agriculture has been busily at work analyzing the various kinds of fertilizers offered for sale in Pennsylvania, in accordance with the law on the subject. In addition to those already announced, the secretary of the state board publishes the result of fiftyeight other analyses, making the entire number thus far submitted to this test one hundred and twenty-one. Out of the last batch analyzed, only seventeen out of the fifty-eight were found to be worth the asked for them. One kind which is sold at \$15, was found to be worth only \$2.05; and on-other sample sold at \$14 was worth \$5.71. Most of the kinds fell far below what their manufacturers claim them to be worth. These facts explain why the results from the use of fertilizers have been disappointing and unsatisfactory to Many are good, worth all that is asked for them, but far the largest number are deceptive, and the farmer who buys them is cheated. Secretary Edge, who was so active in having the present law providing for the analyzation of all the artificial fertilizers offered for sale in the state passed, deserves much credit for having this shield thrown around the agricultural community. If a farmer is now deceived and cheated in the purchase of artificial manure, he has only himself to blame.
