Several of the European governments are joining in an appeal to the Russian court respecting the bitter persecution of the Jews that is disgracing Russia.

York county is the hamper county for the lumber trade. Within its bounds are about 6,000 members of the general synod Lutheran church.

A Green county, Ga., farmer says that if melon vines are clipped off about six inches from the root, the first crop is gathered they will sprout and bear a second crop that will be finer than the first.

The grasshoppers gathered a close harvest of the crops of Jacob W. Everhart, in Penn township, Indiana. Timothy, rye and wheat, cabbage and tobacco plants, currant bushes, corn and clover are eaten to the stem.
