TIMELY HINTS FOR HUSBANDMEN.

Of Value to Those Who Till the Soil.

Ninety-five per cent. of the product of American agriculture is consumed at home.

Experienced agriculturists find profit in rotation and variety of crops. A little of many beats of one.

Go through and pick the small and knobby fruit and enough others to keep the remainder larger and of better quality.

For apple butter, take thirty gallons of sweet cider, that just from the press is to be preferred; boil it down to one-third of the quantity, then add altogether about two bushels of pared, quartered and cored sweet apples, about one-third at a time, judging as to the quantity of apples; then stir the whole mass constantly with a long-handled wooden stirrer, reaching down to the bottom; this stirrer must be from four or five inches broad at the bottom rounded to a little to fit the bottom of the kettle, and have half a dozen or more half-inch holes bored through it. The mass must be kept boiling and stirred until the whole is reduced to say one-half of the original quantity of cider, assumes a dark color, and perfectly smooth and palatable. For this purpose, samples should from time to time be taken out and tasted. When done it should be put in jars, well-lid over with paper, and placed in a cool place.
