NOTE.—The casting vote was as follows: Jackson (Greenback) received 19 votes, of which 17 were cast in the city of Lancaster; Wilson (Prohibition) got 38 votes, 3 being from this city. George Nauman, esq., of this city, received 3 votes for Judge, and William Leaman got 1. Charles F. Wolfe got 2 votes for State Treasurer, and Charles S. Wolfe 3 votes for Judge. John Greider received 1 vote for County Treasurer. J. Mohler received 5 votes for County Commissioner.
