LITTLE LOCALS.

HERE AND THERE AND EVERYWHERE.

Mostly Gleaned From Our Sprightly Country Exchanges.

Willie Bash a lad who lives with Moses Stoltz, near Bulltown, on his way to school accidentally fell off a fence and broke both bones of his right forearm. One day last week the Philadelphia mail bag arrived at Marietta with the hamp broken and lock off, and only three or four letters in the bag. The matter was at once reported but thus far no word has been received as to whether there was robbery or the bag left Philadelphia in that condition.

Noah Campbell, a son of Samuel J. Campbell, at Intercourse, who was married last summer, died suddenly from malignant scarlet fever on Tuesday morning, at the residence of Edwin Barr, at Laurelville, where the deceased and his wife had made their home preparatory to going to housekeeping in the spring.

A daughter of Mrs. Christian Wanner, widow of White Horse in Salisbury township, died of typhoid fever, after an illness of several weeks. The funeral of the deceased was held on Wednesday, and about noon of that day another daughter of the bereft widow died from the same dreadful fever, while two other daughters are ill from the same disease.

The Plant club of Lancaster will have a meeting this evening at 7:30 o'clock, when Rev. J. S. Stahl, of Franklin and Marshall college, will read a paper on "The Place of Botany among the Natural Sciences," after which there will be an examination of specimens of vegetable life under a large number of microscopes. The club work will be the examination of the root and stem.

S. H. Libhart, of Marietta, heard a noise outside the door of his father's kitchen. He went to see, and found a man leaving the alley with a bundle. Mr. Libhart got his shot-gun and went after the fellow, whom he saw going up a canal dropped the bundle and ran away. On examining it there was found three overcoats, three undercoats, vests and several pair of arctic overshoes.

Frank B. Regar, butcher of Adams-town, has furnished the readers of the Intelligencer with a list of the names of the contributors to the fund for the erection of a monument to the memory of the late John J. Adams, who died in the town of Adams during last season, and challenges the Conestoga Valley and the neighborhood of New Holland in particular (where most of the shafts came from) to beat it. They run from 413 to 606, averaging 507.
