FATAL RAILROAD ACCIDENT IN VIRGINIA.
RICHMOND, Va., Feb. 25.—Last night about 8 o'clock a pay train going west on the Richmond & Allegheny railroad ran into a land slide near Buchanan, 20 miles west of Richmond, the collision throwing the engine, tender and pay car off the track and down an embankment into the river. D. McInnis, paymaster's clerk, who was riding on the engine, was killed; G. W. Argel, superintendent of the road, had an arm broken, and Engineer Leib was badly scalded.
