

AT THE PRISON.

JOHN FRANKFORD'S BIG POTION. A Pleasant-Working Cigar Factory - The Representative of the INTELLIGENCER, who called at the prison yesterday, was shown by John Frankford his case, as he has it prepared to lay before the board of pardons at the meeting of that body in May. It is probably the most elaborately devised presentation of an application which has ever gone up from this county. The petition sets forth that he was convicted of stealing Reuben A. Baer's horse and harness and Brackbill's horse, and sentenced in all to 19 years in jail from September 22, 1871, to the present time, Gibson, who was mainly responsible for the crime, only got 8 years; that Frankford has lost one eye and the other is going rapidly; that his health is so impaired that he cannot live his term out, and that if restored to his family the petitioners have confidence he will regain his manhood; it is only asked, however, that his sentence be commuted to the same length as Gibson's, which would make Frankford's term expire in the fall of 1885 - over three years hence.
