Their Prospects Outlined by the New York Times. The small grains, despite bad spring weather, promise well. Winter wheat will give an increased yield in nearly every state except Indiana, Ohio and New York.

Cotton is expected to give at least an average crop. The area devoted to it is much smaller, however, a partial abandonment of the "all cotton" system, and the inability of planters to obtain sufficient supplies work together to result.
