THE LOCAL MARKET DULL.

Few Sales of Old Leaf-The New Crop Very We have another dull week's business to report. Only a few small sales of old tobacco are reported and they were disposed of on private terms. Buyers continue to pick up a few lots of what is left of the crop of 1881, the quality of their purchases being mostly of a low or medium grade.

The interest of our farmers centres just now more in the coming crop than in that of last year. The exceptionally backward spring has greatly retarded their operations. The plants, except those of hot-house growth are small, and as a consequence comparatively few have as yet been set out, and although the first of June is upon us it is safe to say that not one fiftieth part of the plants are yet in the fields.. Cold weather and excessive rains have kept back tobacco planting at least two weeks. New York Market.

U. S. Tobacco Journal. "Duller than ever before known," is the universal statement in the market. The stagnation could hardly be greater. Any sales that were made were, individually, so small that they are not worth specifying. One or two city cigar manufacturers visited the market, but, as far as could be learned, they purchased nothing

of any consequence.

Havana—A moderately fair trade has been done, with no large but several small sales. Prices remain unchanged.

The representative of the Italian Regie purchased 12,244 hogs heads of leaf tobacco at \$150 a hogs-head, so that the bill amoun ted to \$1,830,600. The Philadelphia Market.
