We have five patterns of black Spanish-lace grenadines, all-silk, at \$1.25; all there are in this country, almost certainly.

We have still hundreds of patterns of black grenadine; and the finest are selling at the prices of the not-fine. Generally on fine grenadines the drop in prices is as much as a dollar a yard.

We have now "silk-and-linen" at 50 cents. They look well enough, when new; and we have nothing to say against them at 75 cents.

Ivory nun's veiling, of the quality which we have had for two months at 75 is coming now for 50 cents; 44 inches wide. Ready-to-day.

The variety of light and light-colored woolen fabrics is as great as at any time; and this season has surpassed any before in such. One would certainly be unwise to buy without looking them over.

Embroidered gingham dress-patterns have dropped to two-thirds the prices of a month ago; \$8 to \$10.
