

SLIPPED INTO THE MAIL

POSTAGE DUE ON BEAVER'S LIFE. Immense Quantities of Stewart Campaign Documents Mailed With Insufficient Postage—The Government Loses.

Philadelphia Times. Stories are afloat in different parts of the state about the passage through the mails of Stewart campaign documents, especially a life of General Beaver in book form—at a less rate of postage than required by law.

As soon as the matter was noticed and began to be talked about it reached the ears of Postmaster Heidecker, who cautioned the men handling that class of matter to be more particular, and as a result, large quantities of pamphlets and books began to be returned to the Republican headquarters for more stamps, much to the disgust of those who were sending them out.

As no less than 100,000 copies of the life of General Beaver have been distributed, if they were all sent through the mails at one cent instead of five cent postage it represents at least \$4,000 withheld from the general government, and if the same thing has been done with other documents the loss represented would be much greater.
