Ex-Senator Wallace has accepted the Democratic nomination for Senator in the Thirty-fourth district. He has issued the following address to his constituents: CLEARFIELD, Pa., Oct. 28, 1882.

My life has been spent and will probably be ended among you. Your interests are mine, and in the practice of my profession as a lawyer, my hands will be strengthened for the completion of that work, now fairly launched.

I have acted on the belief that men who labor have the right either singly or in masses to quit that labor for any reason sufficient to them, and that they have no right to prevent those from working who wish to do so.

My daughters say "How much better father is he believed to be the best interest of all of our people. No fair minded man will prescribe the advocate for the fearless performance of his sworn duty, nor can the policy of any party be subordinated to the demands of those who violate law."
