FIRE IN NEW YORK.

A Fatal Biazo Started by an Edison Electrical Light Wire. At a fire Wednesday morning at 243 and 245 Pearl street, New York, one man lost his life and another was seriously injured. At about 10 o'clock, as ten men were working in the basement of No. 243 Pearl street, they noticed a flash of light dart along the electric light wire of the dart along the electric light wire of the Edison company, and in an instant some varnish, which was near the place, exploded. The burning fluid was scattered everywhere Some of it fell on John Brown, of No. 148 Chery street, and he was soon enveloped in flames. He, with the others, rushed to the stairway leading up to Cliff, attack. When he reached the up to Cliff street. When he reached the walk, Brown cried out: "Oh, God! I'm burning up." A truckman who was near by threw a horse blanket around him. The injured man was then taken to a neighboring store and from there to the Chambers street hospital. His left leg was badly burned.

While those in the basement were flee-ing for their lives those in the store of Messrs. Ilsley & Doubleday, who had also heard the noise of the explosion, had made their way to the street and Mr. Doubleday gave the alarm. His nephew, Frank Doubleday, residing in Harlem, however, made his way back again, to go to the safe, it is supposed. He, however, never came out alive, for before he reached the safe he was overpowered by the dense volumes of smoke and suffoctated. The building, which was partially destroyed by fire, is a double five story structure and extends through to Nos. 18 and 20 Cliff stree. The ground floor and basement of No. 243 Pearl street was occupied by Messrs. Ilsley & Doubleday, dealers in paints, oils and varnish, who lose

The ground floor of No. 245 was tenanted by Messrs. William Eggert & Co., tobacco dealers, who sustained a damage of \$10,000. The other losses, by fire, smoke and water, are distributed as follows: On the second floor Mr. Lewis C. Glover, twine and cordage, \$3,000 and the Penusylvania iron works, \$1,000; the third floor, the New York elbow company, \$1,000, and Mr. Charles Brombache, tinmen's tools, \$1,000; forth floor, the Photo electrotype company, \$2,000, and the Empire lithographic and engraving company, \$1,000; tifth floor, Mr. Charles M. Cornwall, printer, \$500, and Messrs. Stilwill & Albertson, printers, \$500. All the losses are covered by iusurances. This is the third time in two years that the place has been on fire.

Fell Inte An Election Bonfire. Wednesday morning shortly after halfpast two o'clock, Cornelius Curtin, aged 25 years, while intoxicated, fell into a bonfire on Avenue D, near Ninth street, New York. He had been electioneering during the day. He was returning to his home, at No. 522 East Thirteen street, when the accident occurred. As he approached Ninth street, near Avenue D, he commenced to cheer for Cleveland and ran toward a large fire that was burning on ing at him walked to the middle of the street to prevent him from falling, but before they reached him he fell into the flames. He was taken out and removed to a drug store in the neighborhood where his injuries were dressed and an ambu lance was summoned. He was taken to Bellevue hospital where his injuries were pronounced very serious, His body and arms were seriously burned, but the physicians hope to save his life.
