

THE TOBACCO MARKET.

TRADE IN SEED LEAF AND HAVANA. For the Week Ending Saturday, November 18, 19 a. m.

Have and the somebody sells a little something or pretends to have sold something, but as a whole business is at a stand still. The cigar manufacturer in this city is not as active as it is expected to be at this time of the year, and there is hardly any of the large manufacturers evincing any desire to purchase at even low figures.

Yes, that may be; but why has nearly every holder of new tobacco in our market got the dyspepsia? The sales of the week were confined to about 500 cases of Havana seed at from 14 to 19 cents, with some filley low grades at 8 cents, and 350 cases '81 Ohio at 4 to 8 cents. A few hundred cases of Pennsylvania were also sold at from 10 to 14 cents.

Sumatra—Continues active, notwithstanding the approaching reduction in import duty. The large importations which will arrive after January 1st are expected to consist of the choicest stock. Sales 300 bales; prices rule from 95 cents to \$1.40. There is very little large and dark stock in the market.

Havana—Moderately active. Sales 500 bales. Prices firm.

BEWARE OF FRAUD.

AN exciting religious revival at the hall of the Heavenly Recruits, No. 1222 North Eleventh street, Philadelphia, was broken up to an abrupt close Sunday afternoon by the death of one of the exhorters. The "Heavenly Recruits" are composed of members of the salvation army, independent Methodists, and other free religious workers, and their meetings are often held in a hall, and are of a striking character. Rude but powerful eloquence has characterized the addresses made to the "recruits." At yesterday's meeting several of the members present had given in their "experience," and there was a revival of the religious fervor which had subsided throughout the hall. Mr. Enoch A. Kerna was particularly excited by the speeches, as was to be expected from his emotional and high strung nature. When the excitement had reached its highest point Mr. Kerna arose to address the meeting. His face was very pale, but he spoke with considerable power, and his remarks made a great impression upon the congregation. As he was about to close some person near him noticed that he appeared to gasp for breath. He tottered and with a sudden fall fell back—dead. There was a great commotion at once, and the dead exhorter was in a moment surrounded by a crowd of mourning friends. He was at once removed to his home, No. 1737 Wallace street. Mr. Kerna has been prominently connected with the Methodist church, and is a member of Trinity church, at Sixteenth and Fairmount avenue. For several months past he has been accustomed to visit the recruits every Sunday afternoon. Some time ago he was a wholesale tobacco dealer on the city of Philadelphia. Recently he retired and devoted his whole time to the church. For several years he has been suffering from a heart affection, and of late has been annoyed more than usual by this trouble.
