The actors in this affair are Mr. and Mrs. Rush Tevis, Mr. Frank Iglehart and a private detective. Mrs. Tevis is a lady well known in St. Louis society. She is a well known in St. Louis society. She is a niece of General Sherman, the commander-in-chief of the army, and of the late Supreme Court Judge Samuel F. Reber. Her father, Colonel Recse, is now in the regular army, but is at present in St. Louis. The lady is quite young, with an exceedingly attractive and intelligent face. She does not look to be more than twenty years old, and she has been the centre of a very bright circle in St. Louis for several years. About four years ago she was married to Mr. Rush Tevis, a son of John C. Tevis, an old and respected citizen of St Lou's, and at present an employee in the wholesale dry goods house of Crow. Har-dine & Co. Every one who knew them supposed that their home on Leonard street was a very happy one. Mrs. Tevis seemed to be thoroughly contented and altogether wrapped up in her baby, now a bright little girl of three years. For some time past, however, there has been a coolness between herself and her husband. Mis. Tevis confided to a friend last week that her husband had been very much annoyed by an anonymous letter that he had received a couple of days before and that he had been to see a private detective about the mater. She held him up and did all that lay in her power or wit to soothe his agony. But once in her carriage she gave way to her grief, and after Iglehart had been taken to his home she went to her father. He could not at first realize what it was the sobbing woman was trying to tell him, and when he did under-stand it and felt that his daughter was testifying against herself, his first impulse was for vengeance, but he soon realized that there was no one upon whom ven-grance could be taken.
