A BROTHER'S REVENGE.

A False Lover Killed by the Brother of a Deceased Girl. William Casey, a Madison county, Ky. man, was twice a widower, his last wife having died in May. He was apparently in search of wife number three, and he had for some time laid a siege to the hand of Miss Pauline East, a pretty young girl of fifteen, daughter of a well-to-do and respectable farmer of Testorsville. Her family was opposed to Casey, and had more than once ordered him away. He seemed to have better luck with the girl, however, for one day last week he induced her under promise of marriage to run off with him. They were gone several days, returning on Saturday with his promise unfulfilled. On Sunday morning, when Owen East, brother of the girl, saw Casey, he accused him of ruining his sister, and, after a few words, knocked him down with a club, breaking his skull and causing death during the night. East has not been arrested yet, though he has made no effort to escape.
