OCEAN CALAMITIES. THE PERILS OF SEA-GOING PEOPLE.

Upwards of Thirty Lives Lost by Disaster at Sea. The British ship Glad Tidings from Calcutta for Falmouth went ashore at Plover Point yesterday. She caught fire afterwards and was totally destroyed. Two of her crew were drowned.

Proceedings in the Senate. WASHINGTON, Dec. 16.—In the Senate at the close of the morning hour Mr. Hawley asked unanimous consent to proceed with the civil service bill, but Messrs. Cockerell and Voorhes objected, preferring to consider bills of the calendar.

Proceedings in the House. WASHINGTON, Dec. 16.—The House at noon went into committee of the whole on the postoffice appropriation bill, the pending amendments being that offered by Mr. Robeson (Mass.) appropriating \$500,000 for special mail facilities and that offered by Mr. Hiseock (N.Y.) reducing that sum to 300,000.

Terrible Domestic Tragedy. An Erie Fellow Driven From Home by a Colored Woman. Baltimore, Dec. 16.—John Scheppler, a laborer, shot his wife this morning while she was lying asleep in bed with her three children by her side. He then shot himself in the temple and fell dead. The wounded wife called for help and attempted to go down stairs, but fell on the floor and died in a few moments.

Democrat Forbes Gives Bill. Philadelphia, Dec. 16.—Dr. W. S. Forbes, of the Jefferson medical college, was brought up in court this morning and required to enter bail in \$5,000 for his appearance at the next term of court to answer charges in connection with the recent wholesale robbery and desecration of graves in the Lebanon cemetery. Dr. Lehman was discharged from custody. The sentence on McNamee, Pillel and Levi and Robert Chew was deferred.

The Tariff Commission's Report. WASHINGTON, Dec. 16.—The ways and means committee spent the morning on the "metals" schedule of the tariff commission's report and after consideration of several items took a recess till two o'clock. This is the important section of the bill and representatives of the iron trade are here to be heard if desired or permitted.

An Accused Railroad President. New York, Dec. 16.—George J. Rice, president of the Utica, Hudson River & Plattsburgh railway, was brought into the Tombs police court this morning, charged with the original stock of that road. His examination was set down for Monday.

Put on the Back List. WASHINGTON, Dec. 16.—About 210 of the Southern Matrimonial and Natal associations have been placed upon the black list of the postoffice department by order of the postoffice general, and postmasters have been instructed to return to the sender money orders addressed to the association.

Another Handy Murderer Convicted. Dublin, Dec. 15.—Thomas Higgins was convicted and sentenced to death today for participation in the murder of the two Huddys.
