WASHINGTON NEWS. THE Ways and Means Committee at Work on the Tariff Commission List. WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—The ways and means committee is at work today upon the free list of the tariff commission report with the prospect of completing it by noon and having it passed by the Senate before the adjournment of the House.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—The Senate today resumed consideration of the bill to afford relief to Congress and the executive departments in the investigation of claims and demands against the government.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—In the House the question of consideration being raised it was determined by voting of 193 to 83 to proceed to the consideration of the shipping bill. The speaker pro tem. (Canton, of Illinois) overruled a point of order raised by Rogers (Tex.) that the bill must be considered in committee of the whole and began speaking from the decision.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—The House committee on appropriations this morning completed the fortification bill and it will probably be reported to the House before the close of to-day's session. The post-office appropriation bill was also reported by subcommittee to full committee today.

A Descriptive Fire. New York, Jan. 6.—The wholesale china store, Irvington Bros., in Fulton street, Brooklyn, was gutted by fire this morning. The New Jerusalem church adjoining was badly damaged and Vandoren's photographic gallery was burned out. Four alarms were sent out and at one time almost the entire department was out saving adjoining property. Irvington's loss is estimated at \$200,000, insurance \$100,000. Vandoren's loss, \$200,000, is covered by insurance.

IMPOSING DEMONSTRATIONS BY THE POPULAR. PARIS, Jan. 6.—The body of Gambetta was placed in a hearse at 10:20 a. m. amid the booming of cannon, beating of drums and sound of trumpets, the military procession, which was two miles long, started at half-past ten. It is estimated there were two hundred thousand persons in the procession. The streets were alive with people and the cortege was very imposing.
