FIGHTING FOR CONTROL. The Contest Between William L. Scott au

Mercer Dispatch to the Press. The contest for the control of the Sharpville railroad between Wm. L. Scott in the interest of the Pennsylvania company and the present management under control of the Pierces, of Sharpsville, continues unabated. This road, which con nects the Oil City and Chicago railroad, at Wilmington Junction, and the New York, Philadelphia and Ohio and Erie and Pittsburgh railroads, at Sharpville. has lately grown in importance on account of the coal fields along its routes, which contribute largely in freights to the competing through lines, and, also, as competing with the Pennsylvania company in freights to and from the furnaces and mills in the Shenan go Valley. Scott, in behalf of the Penn sylvania company, undertook to obtain control over the road and purchased about 3.300 shares of the 7,000 shares of stock. The Pierces, however, in order to protect themselves, bought 400 shares from the Greenville bank, giving them a majority of the stock, but as they had not bought these shares sixty days before the election, the Pierces were enjoined by the court from voting the same. However, Scott had a majority of the votable stock, and voted 3,396 votes for Scott as president and six directors. The Pierce faction voted under the cumulative system 4 550 votes for four directors, but the election board decided in favor of the Soutt ticket. Both boards organized, and the Pierce
