the side that was taken by their ancestors ages ago. It is the Rev. Newton, of Gentle stock, who eulogizes the Gentile kings of Midian who fought against Gideon, and it is the Rev. Dr. Mendes, of Jewish stock, who boldly comes forth here in New York to defend the Jewish Gideon against all assailants.

The question in debate, and that must be settled before the restoration of peace, is whether those "splendidly brave fellows," Zebah and Zalmunna, were unjustly slain by the "savage Jew" Gideon, or in other words, whether the warlike patriot, Gideon, was fully justified in slaying the two Midianite oppressors just named. Almost every debatable question of history is hammered on the anvil in these days, but there is an opportunity for a fair and equitable justice to the theme not yet worn out. Let us form a ring and see what will happen if these parties can be brought to the scratch.

The Rev. Dr. Newton was the first to bring up the case of Gideon in such a way as to give umbrage to the Rev. Dr. Mendes. As all the world knows the Rev. Dr. Newton is preaching a series of sermons on the "Wrong Uses of the Bible," and it was in one of these that, as taken from the Rev. Dr. Mendes' point of view, calling it a "savage Jew" Gideon, and the Rev. Dr. Mendes returned from mentioning Gideon's name; it merely cast a reflection upon one of the most famous of his deeds by glorifying the two Gentile kings whom Gideon slew with his own sword.

The Gentile preacher had been showing how, upon a given occasion, he had scolded about using, in the service of his religion, certain parts of the Jewish Scriptures, and how he felt unable to utter the heathen imprecations of the "cursed Jews in Babylon," when he reached this passage in the Bible.

"Nor could I ask the people to unite in praying: 'Make their nobles like Oreb and Zebah; yes, all their princes as Zebah and Zalmunna.' I had in mind the fate of Oreb and Zebah and of Zebah and Zalmunna, splendidly brave fellows, even in their death, as well as of the eighth and eighth chapters of Judges, where you can learn what sort of prayer this of these savage Jews was. Naturally, as I thought, I objected to voicing such heathen imprecations in the nineteenth century of the era of the Prince of Peace."

Such language of denunciation of Gideon's friends brought to the front, at short notice Gideon's friends; and the Rev. Dr. Mendes, of the Nineteenth street synagogue, who is an adherent of the old Jewish faith, and an enemy of the Gentile crew of "Mediterranean" Jews, and last Saturday, took hold of the Rev. Dr. Newton's sermon, and said it in a way that must have brought a smile of satisfaction to the good face of Gideon himself. "Now, there exists no such thing as a Jew, there exists no such thing as a Gentile, and the Rev. Dr. Mendes, in speaking of the Jews, should avoid committing the fault he condemns."

"Now, there exists no reason to call any of these people 'splendidly brave.' They were Midianite chieftains who had for seven years cruelly oppressed the Hebrews, and Gideon, the patriot, struck the blow for Israel in the year of our Lord 1235, and had driven the oppressed inhabitants to refuge in den, mountains and caves. They were the aggressors. Zebah and Zalmunna possibly were unaccountable for the death of Gideon's bowmen. To condemn Gideon for slaying them, and the Bible narrative when no ground exists for it, is to condemn a wrong on the part of the Bible, and in preaching a sermon upon wrong uses of the Bible the preacher should avoid committing the fault he condemns."
