FATAL AFFAIRS Reported from Various Quarters. An inventor of a rope fire escape, who refused to give his name, tried his apparatus at the corner of Halstead and Madison streets and sustained fatal injuries.

In Syracuse, N. Y., James Brown, colored, was found dead in a barn in the First ward. He was badly beaten a few nights ago by a man named Conroy, and it is thought that death resulted from the injuries received.

Mrs. Samuel Lewis, of Frenchtown, N. J., lies at the point of death, the result of an attempt on her part to commit suicide by cutting her throat. She was suffering from temporary insanity.

A tragic bridge at Racoon, on the East Tennessee, Virginia & Georgia railroad, fell in with the southward bound freight train, Charles Walker, a colored brakeman, and R. Tiddwell, an engineer, were killed, and Carl Kemp and John Cox, passengers were seriously hurt.

Oscar Richardson, an insane patient at the Brattleboro, Vt., asylum, turned the hot water faucet in the bath room and sat in the hot water until he was fatally scalded. He died during the night.

Henry Mallet, an old man of Rutherford, N. C., having quarreled with his son, went to his house armed with a shotgun. Finding it closed, he burst in the door with threats and curses, but as he entered the door the son fired and the father fell dead.

In Princeton, Colusa county, Cal., Dr. A. J. Glenn, the largest heart raiser of the state, who ran for governor on the Demo cratic ticket in 1879 was shot on his ranch at Jacinto, by H. Miller, his bookkeeper. The doctor is said to be dying.

A sad story comes from Deer Island, N. B. A brother, on visiting his sister, who lives in a somewhat out-of-the-way place, on entering the house found four children lying dead from diphtheria, and the mother lying ill in bed with a new-born babe.

William Murphy has surrendered himself at Uniontown, alleging that he murdered a Hungarian in Luzerne county, in September last. Chief of Police Grim, of Wilkesbarre, will arrive in Uniontown in a few days to identify him.

When engine No. 7, a freight train on the Genesee Valley Canal railroad, ran upon the bridge at Allen's creek, near Scottsville, it plunged into the creek. The fireman, Charles Hanna, was killed, and Henry Fuller, the engineer, had his arm broken and foot crushed.
