Early last evening complaint was made by a stranger at the Twentieth District station house, Filbert street, above Fifteenth, that he had been robbed at the Broad street station of a valise containing \$7,000 in gold.

He said that he had arrived from Canada, via New York and Jersey City, in the middle of the afternoon, intending to take the next train for Smyrna, Delaware.

During his walk he had his valise with him. Returning to the depot he took a seat, and while there was accompanied by a man sitting near him, who expressed which way he was going.

He said that he was also going in the same direction, and the two became so friendly that the new found acquaintances asked the owner of the valise to join him in some refreshments in the restaurant.

The latter was not unwilling, but expressed some anxiety as to the safety of his valise, which was lying on a seat between the two.

The former then called to a young man who made his appearance near them, to "keep an eye on the valise until their return," which the young man promised to do.

The two men then entered the restaurant, and while the valise owner was taking a drink the other man slipped out, and with him disappeared the young man who was no doubt an accomplice, and the valise.

He said the valise which was of red leather, also contained a gold watch and clothing, marked "J. W." Information of the robbery was immediately telegraphed to New York, it being supposed that the thieves left for that city on the 5 p. m. train, half an hour before the robbery was reported to the police authorities.
