During the past week about 500 cases of '80 and '81 tobacco were sold by local packers. The largest single sale reported is that of John F. Trippe, who sold to Mr. Rosenshine 100 cases of '80 on private terms.

Buyers are still actively engaged in purchasing the new crop, which is rapidly being transferred from the farmers to the packers. Last week a great deal of changed hands, most of it being low grade tobacco, and sold at low figures.

But little has been done as yet towards the preparation of the ground for the crop of 1883. The spring has been backward and less farm work of any kind has been done than is usual at this time of year.
