IRISH AFFAIRS ACROSS THE OCEAN. The Arrest of Nevin, who is Alleged to Have Deceived His Fellow Americans—A Threatening Letter Causing Alarm in London.

DUBLIN, April 28.—Another arrest has been made in connection with the conspiracy to murder. The prisoner is a tailor named Nevin.

Nevin is the man who was mentioned yesterday by the informer Devine at the hearing of the conspirators, Kingston, Gibney and Healy, as having been appointed by the Fenians to find the hiding place of Fook, who had been mentioned by Devine also.

More Arrests. FULMOR, Ireland, April 28.—Three arrests in connection with the conspiracy to murder have been made here in consequence of information given at the examination of the three conspirators in Dublin, yesterday, by a man named Seery, a resident of Fultamore.

The Guild Building Threatened. LONDON, April 28.—An alarm has been caused by the receipt by the corporation of London of an anonymous letter threatening that body that Guild Hall would be destroyed by dynamite on the 6th of May.
