FARE NOTES. From the "Germanstown Telegraph."

Every farmer should sow a patch, of even an acre or half an acre, of millet for chicken food.

Fowls are very fond of it and it is very fattening. It should not be sown before the middle of May.

Hungarian grass is a species of millet, but it does not grow so tall and the grains or seeds are not so large.

It is a good substitute for nutritious as the common kind, though superior as a fodder for cattle-feeding.

If the patch is chosen where there is a little cover near, it will afford the farmer in the latter part of August, September and a portion of October, to supply his table with fat, delicious meat, which millet is invariably attracts, generally in large numbers, which can be shot with very little trouble or loss of time.

A Simple and Cheap Insect Destroyer. We regard the London Garden to be good authority in horticultural matters in England whatever it may be in the United States.

Still, in matters of insect remedies they will act the same in both countries. It mentions a remedy for the green and black aphides and thrips, which is found to be very effective.

It is to be used 40 gallons of water, let boil an hour, when it becomes very poisonous. It was used last season, and while it destroyed the insects, no ill results were found to the tenderest plants.

It was resorted to after all other known "remedies" were tried. A supply should always be kept on hand. If sprinkled over fruit upon trees, &c., it should be washed off before it has time to dry upon the fruit.

Of course this requires care. Feed the Grape Vine. The oldest grape growers we know always manured their vines plentifully and never dreamed of giving them too much.

Of late years there has arisen a class of grape growers who contend that but little manure is necessary, that in fact the poorer the land the better. We are not among this class.

We have found that the richer the soil the better. We have known even dead animals to be buried about the roots.

—though we think that this is carrying the manure question a little too far. Vines will sometimes fall in rich land, we are aware, but it is from other causes than the soil being too rich; there are other plagues in the way.

It may be the little dusty looking vines which sometimes lay on the vines or its foliage; or it may be the phylloxera which attacks the roots and plays havoc with them; or there may be something in the climate, and so on. We do not pretend to decide the question; we only know that we do the best we can in the cultivation of the vines, and we run far less risk in overfeeding than in starving it.

Garden Labels. It is laid down as an axiom that the more saving by growing one's own vegetables is not all the profit. The pleasure of seeing things grow, and the comparison which one is able to make between one variety and another, have a good deal to do with the satisfaction which a well kept vegetable garden gives.

Yet this latter pleasure is often lost on account of indifference or carelessness in labeling the varieties when the seeds are sown. It is extremely mortifying to take a friend through the garden, and when he admires the particular bean or pea to be unable to remember what they are, and so on all through the garden.

That a piece of chip has been stuck in and penciled with the name, but that is long since illegible. For garden labels there is nothing yet discovered superior to pine sticks cut into lengths of say ten to twelve inches, split thin, one side shaved with a pocket-knife, and then very lightly painted with white-lead, and firmly written on with a pencil.

Every garden should be provided with about a hundred of these and they should be kept conveniently at hand, so as to be just within reach when wanted. This is a hint which may seem to be of the over-practical kind. No doubt everybody feels that "knows already." Perhaps he does, but from the number whom we see neglect it, we feel sure that the hint will not be wholly thrown away.
