URUP REPURTS.

The Untlook for Corn and Wheat. The reports of the correspondents of the agricultural department of Illinois show an improvements in the corn crop in all parts of the state. The area of the growing crop is about 7,000,000 acres, and a crop of 180,000,000 bushels is indicated, with a possibility, if the improvement with a possibility, if the improvement continues, that it may reach 200,000,000.

The state board of agriculture of Ne braska estimates the condition of the crops in that state as follows: Corn, 90 per cent.; spring wheat, 96; rye, 95; oats, 100; barely, 103; flax, 107.—Reports from all parts of Dakota show a slight improvement in the wheat crop. A similar in ment in the wheat crop A similar im provement is noted in the Red River

The Northwestern Miller, of Minneapolis, says; "The wheat stored in the Minneapolis elevators, including the transfer elevator, on July 10 was 1,262,000 bushels.

There were about 475,000 bushels in the mills, making the total amount of wheat in store in the city 1,737,000 bushels against 1,595,000 last week. The wheat stored at St. Paul is about 218,000 bushels. The wheat in store in the Duluth elevator is 330,032 bushels."

The state veterinarian of Illinois reports that glanders are prevalent among the horses in 18 counties of that state. He says the owners prevented him from killing the afflicted animals, their attorneys contending that he could only resort to that measure after the governor had issued a proclamation declaring the glanders evidemic The attorney general is now expected to give an opinion as to the powers of the veterinarian under the state laws.

Railroad Matters.

President Arthur and a number of pro minent officials in Washimgton have been invited to participate in an excursion to the Pacific Coast, over the Northern Pacific railroad, on the occasion of the union of its tracks, and consequent opening of its entire line from St. Paul and Minnea polis and the Lake Superior ports to Portland, Oregon, and Puget Sound. It is expected that the last rail will be laid in Montana in the first week in September. The president will attend, should his en

gagements permit
The Chicago Railway Age publishes
statistics of railway building during the first half of the present year, showing that 2,509 miles of the main track were constructed, not including switches or sidings on 114 lines, in 35 states and territories. During the corresponding period of last year 4,990 miles were built.
