Through a large window can be seen the lawn and the sea in the rear. Folding doors admit the visitor to the dining hall, which also has large windows overlooking the Atlantic. The apartment is furnished from floor to ceiling with mahogany and cherry panels beautifully carved. This room, in common with all the other principal apartments, contains an elegant fire place with carved mantel and plate glass mirror. A magnificent and mahogany canopy covers nearly the entire east side. The casements and doors are of mahogany and the floor is of ash.

In succession, to the east of the dining hall, are the butler's room, pantry, kitchen and laundry.

Across a narrow oak furnished hall is the music room, finished in red wood with high wainscoting and frescoed panels, and numerous shelves above the fireplace and to one side of the same. Three large windows permit a broad view of the front lawn and the cliffs to the eastward. On the left a door opens into a billiard room, the cherry wainscot of which is as high as the doors, leaving a large border for frescoes. The windows command a view of the lawn and the sea.

Diagonally across the large hall, the uniform oak hue of which contrasts admirably with the wood colors in the adjoining apartments, an entrance is obtained through folding doors into the drawing room. The woodwork of the apartment is ivory white, and the walls are covered with an embossed papier mache frieze.

A mirror framed in brass filigree work rests upon white velvet above an elegantly tiled fireplace. Admirable wood carvings are the most striking features of the room, which commands a view of the cliffs to the westward and the restless surface of the ocean. A door from the drawing room opens into the library, a large apartment, the woodwork of which is painted in a terra cotta shade. Large windows command a view of both front and rear lawns. Access is had to the large veranda, which begins here and runs around the west and south sides as far as the butler's room. Broad steps connect the veranda with the terrace and the terrace with the lawn.

Over the library is a room with tinted walls and ivory white wood, with a bay window overlooking the carriage way to the gates. A bath room and cedar closets are connected with this and another with the bedroom adjoining, over the drawing room. The joiner work and finish in these and the apartments for guests are of the finest; these two rooms are furnished with electric bell-calls. The other bedrooms are finished in pine either painted or varnished, the floors being of hard pine. In the eastern wing are also

two bath rooms, with numerous rooms for servants, who have also accommodations above the principal building.
