FOR THE HUSBANDMAN.

How sweet Potatoes should be kept.

As this matter is now to be considered, and as the farmers outside of sweet potato regions find much difficulty in saving the few that they raise for their own consumption, as well as when they wish to put up enough for winter of other people's raising, we have to say that we have seen a number of methods recommended, and have some experience ourselves.

The following looks as though it might answer very well, and it is adopted by an experienced Jersey grower, and we think that there is little risk run in following it: The potatoes are dug after the first sharp frost, and left to lay as dug until near evening, when they are covered with the vines, and the morning the vines are removed and the sun goes on with the drying process.

We have also known them to be packed in boxes, each potato being wrapped up in paper, and the boxes placed in cellars where there is no danger of freezing, as this potato is very susceptible of being nipped, and when once touched they decay rapidly.

Gardeners understand the good effect of turning up the soil late in the fall has upon the next year's crops; but there are many who—those who have small gardens, and in this class are many our well-to-do farmers—who, by neglecting this work, only raise half a crop of vegetables, and these of an inferior quality, and then they wonder why their more knowing neighbors do so much better.
