MOUAT TO BE RELEASED.

Court Proceedings That Will Dispose of the Other Charges Against aim.

Four bills of indictment charging David Monat the Philadelphia Republican councilmen, with election frauds were submitted without evidence to a jury of Judge Allison's court of quarter sessions in Philadelphia yesterday and a verdict of not guilty taken. The bills all related to the orime of altering the tally list of the Sixtenth division of the Fifth ward at the February election in 1880, to which Monat. February election in 1380, to which Mouat, after a mis trial, pleaded guilty about two years ago and for which he was sentenced to an imprisonment of two years. District Attoney Graham, in asking the court's leave to submit the bills, which would otherwise act as a detainer, said: "I am fully persuaded that the punishment already imposed answer the demands of justice." The court signified its approval and the matter was disposed of. Two of the bills were against Mouat alone. The others charged him with conspiracy to cheat with William O'Dea, George Cornelius are dead. Kelly fled the jurisdiction of the court and was never arrested. Mouat term will expire on Sunday next.

Twenty Thousand Roses for a Ball Room.

The managers of the farewell ball to the Princess Louise, at Montreal on Mon-day evening, the 15th instant, have con-tracted with Mr. Thomas F. Galvin, our well known florist, to do the floral work, and it is, in all probability, the largest floral order that has ever been given to a single house in this country. The various designs that are to be made will require a special car to transport them to Montreal. Mr. Galvin estimates that he will use at least 20,000 roses—Jacqueminots, Sou veniss, Marshal Neils, Baroness Rothschilds, Bon Silenes and other varieties; 20,000 carnations of different colors; 1,000 spikes of tuberoses, 500 bunches of violets, 1,000 sprays of heliotrope, 2,000 strings of smilax, 2,000 yards of English laurel and other flowers and foliage in proportion. Eight florists will be engaged in decorat ing the banquet and ball rooms and it is confidently anticipated that the display of flowers will be the finest ever seen on this continent.
