THE SPEAKERSHIP.

An Embroider Sentenced—Public Deb. Washington, D. C., Dec. 1.—Benjamin F. Bigelow, late receiving teller of the Bank of the Republic, recently convicted of embezzlement, was today sentenced by Judge Wylie to one year's imprisonment in the New Hampshire penitentiary.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 1.

The strike among the oil cloth printers resulted in a general lockout this morning. Of the 108 employees of Rufus Potter, Sons & Co. all except 15 refused to sign an agreement to sever their connection with the union.

CHICAGO, Dec. 1.

The cigar manufacturers have decided to close their shops against the members of the Cigar makers' union, No. 14, on account of the refusal of the latter to work with the members of the Progressive Union.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 1.

The trial of Patrick O'Donnell for the murder of Carey, the informer, was resumed at 10 o'clock this morning. The court was crowded, but there were few persons outside.

SAVANNAH, Ga., Dec. 1.

At Nahutta yesterday, Jennie Murray, colored, shot and instantly killed her stepfather, William Troup, while he was trying to restrain her from entering his house with a strange man.

READING, Pa., Dec. 1.

Harry Bausaged 16, and a stranger, presumably a tramp, slept last night in Ecker's furnace and this morning both were found dead, having been suffocated by sulphuric gas.
