

THE LATEST PHASE OF IRISH AFFAIRS.

Joseph Poole Hanged in Dublin To-Day—He Was Liked O'Donnell—London Quaking with Excitement from Threats of Ven-

DUBLIN, Dec. 18.—Joseph Poole was hanged at eight o'clock this morning for the murder of John Kenny.

The execution took place in Richmond-Bridewell. Kenny was killed by Pooles on the night of July 4, 1883, in Zelle Place, this city.

The Execution. Poole rose this morning at 5:30 o'clock, and the priest shortly after visited him and administered the sacrament.

The executioner was a man from the north of Ireland, whose name was given out as "Jones". That, however, was not supposed to be his real name.

A farmer named Philip McGavin was murdered in County Cavan yesterday. The crime was due to agrarianism.
