Robert Martin Hanged for the Murder of His Wife - Jan. 3, 1884. The body was delivered to his friends for burial.

James H. Graves was hanged at 11:04 o'clock. He had been carried to the scaffold. Graves, who was 55 years of age, was a recluse, and for several years lived here with a family named Soden.

The execution of Robert Martin and James H. Graves took place quietly this morning in the Essex county jail. The prisoners slept well during the night, and this morning awoke at a hearty breakfast.

The sheriff and his deputies immediately went for Graves, who was in the hospital room, where the death warrant was read and he was brought to the gallows. He sobbed and moaned piteously.

Martin gave his usual short address to the public, expressing deep sorrow for the shedding of innocent blood, and attributing the crime to the influence of disease, medicine and liquor, which had had an unusual effect on him, setting forth that he had no malice against any one.
