WARLIKE EUROPE.

THE RETURNED STATE OF TONGKIN. Pirates Attack the Towns of Nam Dinh and Hanoi and Many Citizens Killed—The Count of Paris Spoken With—Other Foreign Affairs.

LONDON, Jan. 14.—A dispatch from Hong Kong, China, and dated Monday, 10.35 a. m. states that a vessel from Ha Noi, dated the 6th, announces that Chinese pirates made an attack upon Nam Dinh in Tonquin from all sides on the nights of the 1st and 2nd inst., in which a large number of the citizens were killed and wounded and many houses were burned. On the 4th inst. the post of Hanoi, near Ha Noi, was also attacked, but the enemy was compelled to retire in disorder, carrying away many killed and wounded.

Tudou, formerly king of Annam, is recognizing the insurgent bands. Advice from Sontay states that nearly all the fugitives from that place, upon its capture by the French, are turning supplied with arms.

The Count de Paris Demonstration. The Paris correspondent of the Daily News says: There were many more arrests than at first stated in connection with the demonstration at the railway depot on the 11th upon departure of the Count and Countess de Paris for Madrid, and the charges against the prisoners are likely to result in a serious indictment. The correspondent says it will be dangerous for the count to return to Paris unless he shall have support from high quarters in France.

Suspected Dynamiters. The trial of Wm. Woolf and Edward Biddar, charged with being in possession of dynamite for unlawful purposes, was begun in London to day.

A Steamer Wrecked. SHANGHAI, China, Jan. 13.—The steamer Hwaiyuen, from this port for Hong Kong, has been wrecked on the Ho San Island. Five natives were saved, but nothing is known of the rest of the consisting of six Europeans and 195 natives.

Alleged Government Enemies. TRIESTE, Jan. 14.—Herr Tomasi, a schoolmaster, and six of his pupils, have been arrested upon the charge of irreligious intrigues.

RAILROAD MATTERS. The Annual Meeting of the P. & E. R. R. Stockholders To-day. PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 14.—The annual meeting of the stockholders of the Philadelphia & Reading railroad was held here to-day. The proceedings have been purely formal and devoid of excitement. E. S. Wheeler was called upon to preside.

LATER.—The annual report shows a surplus of \$2,137,232, allowing 7 per cent. on preferred and 5 per cent. on common stock. The report speaks of great increase of anthracite coal production and predicts a demand before long equal to the producing power of the entire property. The report closes with a recommendation for the creation of a collateral trust fund of \$5,000,000 floating debt, income mortgage bonds and to purchase the 50,000 shares of Jersey Central. A series of resolutions were adopted, endorsing the contracts and engagements recommended and the proposed collateral trust fund.

Mr. Gowen offered a resolution to be acted on the 28th, endorsing the collateral trust fund and its objects as stated, and declaring that a dividend of 21 per cent. on cash on preferred stock and 10 per cent. on common stock in cash on common stock. The meeting then proceeded to vote for officers as follows: President, Geo. B. De Keim; Loring Robertson, director, in place of Eckley Coke, and William A. Church as treasurer instead of Mr. Bradford. There was no opposition to these candidates.

A resolution was then adopted to adjourn until the 28th inst., to enable stockholders meanwhile to examine the report of the managers.

Graduated President. S. Clinton Gardner was to day elected president of the Buffalo, New York and Pittsburgh railroad.

BY WIRE. Afternoon Telegrams in Brief. The funeral at St. Louis, of the victims of the recent Belleville fire was largely attended.

The steamer City, disabled some days ago, was picked up by the Britanic off Cape Pastrel. All are well on board. Her broken shaft will be repaired at Liverpool.

It is developed at Reading that the death of Isaac Wootten there last week was the result of a severe beating by roughs in Philadelphia.

The Episcopal church at Middleport, N. Y., burned this morning. Loss, 13,000; insurance, \$2,000.

At Belfast, Me., to day, Emma J. Sanford obtained a verdict for \$90 for breach of promise against John S. Ayer, a member of the Legislature.

The Baptist church at Port Norris, N. J., burned yesterday. Loss, \$5,000.

The body of Charles Delmonico was found this morning by two boys in the woods of the Orange mountains near the summer residence of General McJellan, near Newark, N. J. No marks of violence were found on the body and no evidence of robbery. Death was from exhaustion.

Who Will Be Elected President of the Senate. WASHINGTON, Jan. 14.—The Republican senators in caucus to day decided that if Senator Anthony declines the presidency as president pro tempore of the Senate, as he undoubtedly will, Senator Edmunds shall be elected.

Anthony's Election and Declines. The Senate to day elected Mr. Anthony president pro tempore. Mr. Anthony, in a few fitting words and much feeling, declined the honor, owing to the precarious state of his health. Edmunds was then elected pro tempore.

PHOTOGRAPHS. A \$140,000 Fire. NEW YORK, Jan. 14.—Lawrence & Co.'s four-story warehouse, on East street, burned this morning. The loss will be less than \$100,000 shared by half a dozen persons who have goods stored there. The principal losses are Waterbury & Co., rope manufacturers, \$100,000; J. L. & D. S. Piker, dye stuffs, \$20,000; Wm. Kippling the insurance pot was hurt by a fall.
