HOW TO TREAT ROUP.

There are two phases of roup known to the poultry keeper—the acute and chronic—both of which, if not taken in hand, prove fatal.

The acute is produced by sudden changes of the weather, especially when the change is accomplished by cold winds during the months from October to April.

The chronic is produced by drafts; later by wet and a sudden cold path from the damp chilliness of early spring.

Great success is attained by the use of a liberal dose of the oil also. Swab the eyes and mouth with equal water, removing the bad humor, and wash the eyes and face with a solution of sugar of lead.

The first food should be given at once, consisting of a mixture of equal parts of cracked corn and soft bread.

A wetter, either in the form of a water bottle or a spray, should be kept constantly running over the poultry.
