ON THE FARM.

Brief Notes of General Interest. The whole number of farm animals in the country has been increased since February, 1883, by 4,000,000.

The largest increase is in stock cattle, and is principally in the states west of the Mississippi. Stable animals require much fresh air, and to secure it there must be a way of escape for the foul gases forming in the stable.

The wages of the farm laborers (including board) now range from \$13.67 per month in the states where agriculture occupies 77 per cent. of the laboring population, to \$24.14 per month in the states where only 15 per cent. of the workers are engaged in agricultural pursuits.

The laying season for the bees is soon coming. More colonies perish between March 20th and the 1st of May—a general rule—than from October 1st to March in this latitude.
