A TOBACCO "BOOM." THE '83 CROP IN GREAT DEMAND. Buyers on the War Path Through Seed and Leaf--Heavy Deliveries at the City Warehouses--Our Local Market.

The long deferred but confidently predicted "boom" in '83 Lancaster county tobacco has arrived. A few weeks ago the farmers, who had planted the tobacco in the Chinese lingo, that it was "all well and no buy-ee."

The much desired and reasonably expected boom has not yet commenced on the seed leaf market, but its coming is, nevertheless, inevitable, and that speedily.

The interest in the '83 tobacco on the part of jobbers and manufacturers is growing. Incoming samples are inspected with absorbing eagerness.

Following are the sales of seed leaf tobacco reported by J. S. Gans' Son & Co., tobacco brokers, No. 131 Water street, New York, for the week ending Mar. 24, 1884:

500 cases 1881 Pennsylvania, 6@11 1/2; 200 cases 1882 Pennsylvania, 5@25; 132 cases 1882 Wisconsin Havana seed, 30@32 1/2; 190 cases 1882 New England, 8@9; 100 cases 1882 Ohio, 6@12 1/2. Total, 1,082 cases.
