

AN ARCHBISHOP ON FREE MASONRY. As a high Prelate denounces the Organization as Revolutionary—Italy Levying Tribute From Inactive Egypt.

Dublin, June 23.—Archbishop McCabe has written a letter with reference to the approaching election of a Lord Mayor for Dublin. He says he is unable to understand how Catholics could in honor and conscience cast their votes for Mr. Win-stanley, who is both a Home Ruler and a Free Mason. As a Free Mason he is a member of a society which aims at overthrowing religion. To Free Masonry the revolutions of the last century were traceable. No one can plead non-participation as long as he remains a Mason.

London, June 23.—A dispatch from Aden states that the Italian man of war, Capt. Fido, recently visited Zeyla, an African seaport on the straits of Bab-el-Mandeb, subject to Egypt, threatened to bombard the place and exact a large sum of money from the Governor. Great excitement was caused, but confidence was restored by the arrival of the British gunboat Arab.
