Three men at Erie have been poisoned by eating canned beef.**Sixty masked men broke open the jail at Russellville, Ky., on Sunday night, took out Richard Henderson, colored, and lynched him. He had cut the throat of a white boy, but not fatally.****Lingi Panati was stabbed to death by Antonio Fresoli in a quarrel at McKeesport, Pa., on Sunday night. The murderer escaped.****Edward Bopp, 20 years of age, was drowned on Monday morning while fishing in the Potomac river, at Cumberland, Md. He was subject to epileptic fits, and is supposed to have been seized with one while drowned.****A freight train on the Missouri Pacific railroad ran through a burning bridge near Checotah, Texas, on Sunday. Ten cars were demolished and burned, and the brakeman was killed.****Emile Gargi's Philadelphia "female baseball players" are stranded in Baltimore, and cannot raise funds to return to their homes.****Announcement has been made in New York of the purchase by the Pennsylvania railroad company of the Sodus Bay & Southern railroad, connecting at Stanley, New York, with the Northern Central railroad, and running north to Great Sodus bay, at Lake Ontario.****M. T. Potter, a Philadelphian, wearing a most striking costume composed of stars and stripes, received all the chief honors of the day Sunday in the Bois de Boulogne, foot of races, Paris, winning the 1,000 meters race easily, also the Prix de Nice medal in the 100 metre dash, although heavily handicapped.****SUNNY SPAIN.****Report of the Cuban Commission.**
The commission of five sent to Havana from Madrid have prepared their report regarding the condition of Cuba and the question of selling it, and have submitted a copy of it to the captain general. The latter strongly disapproves its conclusions, as, if they were followed, he would cease to be chief ruler of the island. The report is signed by only three of the commissioners, the other two will make a minority report, and all five will leave for Spain on the steamer which sails next week. The following is understood to be a synopsis of the report:**The majority of the commissioners are of opinion that the interests of Spain demand that she should be relieved of Cuba before an insurrection should succeed or bank ruptcy in the island should produce results like those of 1821-1823. The commissioners were warned from the mother country.
