Council held their monthly meeting last night in the council chamber.

Finance committee reported.

Highway committee reported that they have reviewed plans for a new bridge.

The police and sanitary committee reported the town healthy and generally quiet.

A committee of the trustees of the old Columbia public good company sent a communication to council about the opening of Cherry street and Sixth street.

Tax Collector W. G. Dittenhofer appeared before council stating that the leading A. Columbia railroad company had sent him a check for \$73.81 for tax which was \$1.80 short of the amount.

An ordinance was presented to prohibit the wheeling of coal, stone, lime, sand, curbs and wagons on our pavements.

The finance committee asked for an order in favor of the First National bank cashier for \$10,000 in payment of bonds redeemed.

Chief Burgess Irwin reported that Potter's field was in bad condition.

A resolution was passed instructing the highway committee to prepare a bridge street to receive the drainage from the alley and streets that are to be opened.

The property committee was empowered to dispose of all the water out of the sewer between here and the above named points.

Mr. Wolfe, butcher, was exonerated from paying rent for his market stall for the balance of the year, as he has stopped business and paid for four months.

The skating rink will not be built in Columbia, as the parties concerned have altered their plans.

A special meeting of the Columbia fire company will be held Monday night.
