

TENTH ANNUAL CONVENTION

Amanda Grimley, who has been an inmate of the county almshouse for several weeks, was taken before Judge Livingston on a writ of habeas corpus this morning.

It appears that Amanda became an inmate of that institution a few weeks before her confinement, and at the last term of the court the father of her illegitimate child, a young man named Bietler, received the court's sentence. Amanda had no home to go to, and after the trial she went back to the almshouse.

On Monday, Harry W. Dittenbach, butcher, went to the almshouse to see Amanda, and in the family. He was told by Steward Brak that the rules of the poor directors required that \$25 be paid for the expense of maintaining the girl during her illness, or that she should have to work as a domestic in the institution for six months.

Mr. Dittenbach did not think the girl could legally be held by the poor directors, and he employed an attorney and had the girl taken before Judge Livingston on a writ of habeas corpus, to have her discharged from the almshouse.

The board of directors had no authority to detain the girl and directed her discharge from the custody of the almshouse officials.

Charles W. Walton, James Young and John G. Gill, the three men arrested at the fair grounds on suspicion of being pickpockets, were taken before Alderman Sanson this morning.
