

Convicts Lushed at New Castle. WILMINGTON, Dal., Sept. 20.-Seven convicts were whipped at New Castle this morning in the presence of about 4,000 people. Among them were Ed. Reddey, white, who was pillored for an hour and got 20 lashes, Isaac Anderson, a negro boy, who swore justily while being whipped, and a colored thief named Sagor Awful, who took twenty heavy lashes without a murmur.

Exemption From Yellow Fever. WASHINGTON, Sept. 20 .- The acting as-istant surguon at Brownsville, Texas, reports to the surgoon general that there bas been no cases of yellow fever at Matamoras, Mexico, nor at Brownsville, and that the season at the Mexican gulf parts has been one of the healthiest ever known. The fever is decreasing at Her-monsville, Mexico.


